To have faith is to believe in something; to trust that it is so. Some people believe everything they are told. Others require proof for everything. Most people cannot have faith in something unless they know something about it. That is why God has always provided man with lots of proof of his existence and his love – so we can easily believe it and have faith in him.

Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

The lame man **heard** the **word of God** from Paul and **believed** as observed by Paul. He therefore **had faith** to receive **healing**.

Grace, a friend of yours from Sunday school who also goes to your school is seen in the toilet bullying another girl along with others. You later confront her asking her about her faith in God.


She tells you she does not believe in God anymore. What will you say to her?
